### HEALTH



Because you gave:

- More than \$33 million in medications were ordered and dispensed to patients at little or no cost through the Patient Assistance Program. (Victory Health Partners)
- 1,945 counseling sessions were provided for 281 new child abuse victims and ongoing counseling for 817 existing clients. (The Child Advocacy Center)
- 359 trips were provided to life-sustaining medical appointments for local seniors. (Dumas Wesley Community Center)

### FINANCIAL STABILITY



Because you gave:

- 125 individuals with developmental disabilities were served in the Job Ready Program, which helps them develop living skills & job readiness. (Mobile Arc)
- 931 individuals received counseling on personal financial issues and needs. (Lifelines Counseling Services)
- 87 families were provided with employment readiness training & services through the Family Haven. (The Salvation Army of Coastal Alabama)

### EDUCATION



Because you gave:

- Approximately 9,000 hours of classroom instruction were provided for participants of the Adult Education Program. (Goodwill Easter Seals of the Gulf Coast)
- More than 400 children ages 6 weeks through 5 years received high-quality early learning services on a weekly basis. (Child Day Care Association & Gulf Regional Early Childhood Services)
- 97% of mentees reported being more confident they will finish high school. (Big Brothers Big Sisters of South Alabama)

### ESSENTIALS



Because you gave:

- More than 3.4 million pounds of food was distributed in Clarke, Mobile, and Washington counties, equating to approximately 2,834,000 meals with a wholesale value of more than \$5 million. (Feeding the Gulf Coast)
- 52,572 meals were served to clients receiving shelter in Mobile & Washington counties. (McKemie Place & Penelope House, Inc.)
- 84% of clients in the Supportive Services for Veterans were able to maintain stable housing for at least nine months. (Housing First, Inc.)
