




Opportunities to volunteer

United Way Volunteer Connect is a recruitment and management website that increases volunteerism and mobilizes resources by offering opportunities for individuals and groups to volunteer.

Last year, 820 volunteer needs were met through Volunteer Connect, resulting in an economic impact of more than \$33,620 in volunteer hours served.



Referrals for supportive services

Through a UWSWA partnership with Lifelines Counseling Services, trained United Way 2-1-1 Help Line call specialists provide individuals seeking assistance free and confidential referrals to community services.

Last year, United Way of Southwest Alabama's 2-1-1 Help Line answered 9,197 incoming calls and provided 8,406 referrals to health and human services.



Prescription savings cards

In partnership with FamilyWize, UWSWA distributes prescription drug cards that provide savings for individuals who do not have insurance or need medications not covered by insurance.

In 2018, individuals in Southwest Alabama have saved more than \$1.1 million using the FamilyWize Prescription Savings Card.



Free books for preschoolers

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library program provides eligible children a monthly age-appropriate book in the mail, free of charge, until the child's fifth birthday.

Last year, Dolly Parton's Imagination Library provided a total of 12,261 books to 978 children in Mobile and Choctaw counties.



Free tax preparation

Through the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program, UWSWA provides free federal and state e-filing assistance.

Last year, VITA volunteers prepared 2,950 tax returns and helped return more than \$3.5 million in tax returns and savings to our community.
